Residential Burglaries 016th District (Jefferson Park)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 16th District (Jefferson Park) of several residential burglaries that have occurred in the months of March and April. In these incidents, unknown offender(s) entered residences through the front/rear doors or windows. The offenders took electronics, jewelry, cash, and other miscellaneous items.

Incident times and locations:

There have been several incidents that have occurred since March 08, 2016. These incidents have taken place on Beat 1623, within the boundaries of Elston to Montrose and Cicero to Central, mostly during the day and early evening hours.
