ARMED ROBBERIES 14th District – Shakespeare

About the Crime:

In each case, the offenders approach the victim on the street or alley, and announce a robbery. The offenders display a handgun and go through the victim's pockets and remove property. The offenders flee on foot. The victims are returning home and maybe distracted by texting.

Incident times and locations:

- 1484 N Milwaukee, Tuesday, March 29, 2016, 1:30 AM
- 1501 N Paulina, Saturday, April 2, 2016, 2:30 AM
- 1397 N Wood, Saturday, April 2, 2016, 3:30 AM

About the Offender:

Two offenders, both male blacks in their 20's, armed with a handgun. The first offender is 5'9" to 6'00" tall, weighs approximately 170 pounds, has a dark complexion and black curly hair, with no further description; the second offender is 5'8" to 5'9" tall, weighs 150 to 165 pounds, and has a dark complexion, with no further description.

What you can do:

- Be aware of this crime.
- Be aware of your personal environment when walking at night
- If you are confronted by a robber remain calm
- Remember any unique physical characteristics (scars, limp, acne, teeth, etc...)
- Pay special attention to any suspicious persons or vehicles loitering in the area.
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender - include vehicle descriptions and license plates
