### **Ashburn Man Charged in String of Boost Mobile Robberies**



**Offender:** Dionte Smith, 21  
3500 W, 79<sup>th</sup> St.

**Charges:** Three felony counts of – Robbery – Armed – Other Dangerous Weapon

**Court Info:** Central Bond Court – 26<sup>th</sup> and California; April 13, 2016

**Narrative:** Dionte Smith was identified through latent prints and victim identification in three armed robberies of Boost Mobile stores. These incidents occurred in the 5100 block of S. Kedzie Ave. on March 31, 2016 at 12:50 p.m.; 6400 block of S. Pulaski Ave., on March 31, 2016 at 8:50 p.m.; and the 6600 block of S. Cicero Ave., on April 2, 2016 at 2:22 p.m. Smith was charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
