

Wanted for Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse

About the Crime:

- On April 23rd, 2016 at approximately 8:00 p.m. an unknown male offender approached an 11 year old male child victim as he was riding his bicycle with other children around the area of the 4800 block of West Cornelia Ave. The offender grabbed the victim and inappropriately touched him and stated "I thought you were my girlfriend." Several citizens came out to help the children and the offender fled northbound on Cicero Ave.

About the Offender:

- The offender was described as a white male, 5'09", 200lbs, between 30 – 25 years of age. Offender is bald and has blue or hazel eyes. Offender was last seen wearing a black sweatshirt, yellow safety vest, jeans and black shoes.

What you can do:

- Call 911 to report any suspicious persons or activity.
- Walk in groups if possible.
- Don't talk to strangers or approach strange vehicles.
- Be aware of your surroundings and travel in well-lit and populated areas.
- Use phones and electronic devices only as necessary until in a safe area.
