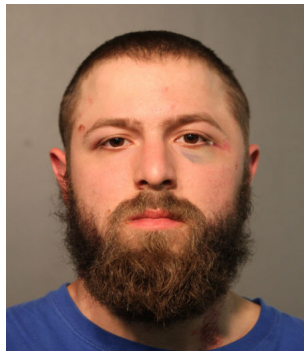

### North Side Man Charged in Stabbing



**Offender:** Christopher Holmes, 25  
500 Block of W. Aldine Ave.

**Charges:** One Felony Count of Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm

**Court Info:** Central Bond Court – 26<sup>th</sup> and California May 10, 2016

**Narrative:** Holmes was arrested and charged after being positively identified as the person who stabbed a 28-year-old man on May 9, 2016 at approximately 1:30 a.m. in the 500 block of W. Aldine. Holmes and the victim were in an apartment consuming alcohol when they began to argue. Holmes then grabbed a knife and stabbed the victim multiple times in the back and legs. The victim was transported to Illinois Masonic in stable condition where he was treated for his injuries. Holmes was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No further details are available at this time.
