Burglary 001st District (Central)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to businesses operating in the 001st District (Central) of an increase in burglary related incidents during the month of September. Unknown offender(s) have forcibly entered retail stores, restaurants and business offices by breaking glass doors or windows, or opening unlocked windows, to enter and take electronics, cash and alcohol. These incidents have occurred during the midnight to early morning hours in the general geographical locations listed below:

- 2000 block of S. Calumet Ave. on 12 September 2016 at 3:30 6:30 AM

- 2300 block of S. Michigan Ave. on 14 September 2016 at 1:30 7:00 AM
- 1700 block of S. Wabash Ave. on 14 September 2016 at 1:55- 3:10 AM

About the offenders:

- HZ431757: male black, gray long sleeve shirt, gray sweatpants, white gym shoes.
- HZ434190: male, white, 5'07-5'11, 160 -180, shaggy brown hair, light complexion, black skull cap, Gray t-shirt with "Windy City" in red print, black shorts, black gloves, gray gym shoes, black back pack.
