Shooter Arrested and Charged in the Robbery and Shooting of 71 year old Chicago Lawn Man



- Offender:** Antoine J. Davis, 30
6800 block of S. Washtenaw Ave
Chicago, Illinois
- Charges:** One felony count of Robbery – Armed with Firearm
One felony count of Aggravated Battery – Discharge Firearm
- Court:** Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California Avenue – September 17, 2016
- Narrative:** Antoine Davis was arrested in connection to the robbery and shooting of a 71 year old man, which occurred on the 7000 block of South California Ave. at approx. 12:10 p.m. on September 6th, 2016. Davis was charged after being identified as the armed male offender who approached the 71 year old male victim, who was watering his lawn at the time, and robbed him of his wallet. During the robbery, Davis shot the victim in the abdomen and then fled the scene on a bicycle. The victim was subsequently transported to Mt. Sinai Hospital in serious condition. Officers assigned to the CPD Fugitive Apprehension Unit, in conjunction with members of the US Marshals Great Lakes Task Force, arrested Davis outside his residence at approx. 4:15 p.m. on September 16th, 2016. No further information is available at this time.
