Residential Burglaries 016th District (Jefferson Park)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 16th District (Jefferson Park) of residential burglaries that have occurred in the month of September 2016. In these incidents, unknown offender(s) gain entry by forcibly kicking or prying open the front door and windows. Offender(s) then take jewelry, cash and copper pipes.

There have been incidents that have occurred since September 06, 2016. These incidents have taken place, within the boundaries of Belmont to Montrose/Forest Preserve Drive and Narragansett to Harlem.
