### Englewood Man Charged in Buena Park Shooting



- Offender:** Victor Haynes, 31  
400 block of W. 65<sup>th</sup> Place
- Charges:** Two felony counts of Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm  
One felony count of UUW – Weapon – Felon, Possess/Use Firearm
- Court:** Central Bond Court - 2600 S. California Avenue – December 20, 2016
- Narrative:** Haynes was placed into custody after being identified as the offender who committed an Aggravated Battery on December 18, 2016 on the 500 block of W. Irving Park Dr. at approximately 1:53 a.m. During this incident, Haynes became involved in a verbal altercation with two males and subsequently fired a handgun striking a 33-year-old male in the chest and a 38-year-old male in the head. The 33-year-old was taken to Northwestern Hospital in stable condition and the 38-year-old was transported to Illinois Masonic in critical condition. Haynes fled the scene but was taken into custody on the 3500 block of N. Lake Shore Dr. a short time later. The offender was also transported to Illinois Masonic Hospital for treatment of what is thought to be a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the left hand. Haynes has been charged accordingly.
