Motor Vehicle Thefts 016th District (Jefferson Park)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 16th District (Jefferson Park) of a recent increase in motor vehicle thefts during the month of January. Offender(s) utilized a "Slim Jim" type device or a pry tool to make entry into the vehicle.

Numerous vehicles that have been left unattended, unlocked and running while the owners were in the process of warming up them up have been stolen.

Incident times and locations:

Several incidents have occurred since January 01, 2017. The majority of incidents have taken place within the boundaries of Belmont to Irving and Cicero to Cumberland.

About the Offender(s):

Offender(s) descriptions vary.

What you can do:

- Be aware of this crime pattern and alert your friends and family about these crimes.
- Park you vehicle in a well lit location.
- Completely secure your vehicle when leaving, for any duration.
- Never leave your vehicle unlocked or running while unattended.
- Pay special attention to any suspicious subjects loitering in the area.
- Remove any visible items from the interior of the vehicle.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s), including any vehicle description and license plate information, as well as direction of flight, if known.
