## **Residential Burglaries 019<sup>th</sup> District (Town Hall)**

### **About the Crime:**

This alert gives notice of several Residential Burglaries that have occurred within the boundaries of the 019<sup>th</sup> District (Town Hall). These burglaries have occurred on Beat 1924, primarily in the area of Addison to Belmont, and Southport to Halsted. In these burglaries, the offender(s) forcibly or unlawfully enter the residence through a door or window and removed property.

### **Incident times and locations:**

- 1100 block of W. Roscoe on January 21, 2017 between 1:30 pm & 4:15 pm.
- 3500 block of N. Fremont on January 24, 2017 at 4:15 am.
- 3300 block of N. Lakewood on January 30, 2017 between 9:00 am & 9:00 pm.
- 1200 block of W. Addison on January 30, 2017 between 11:00 am & 3:00 pm.
- 1000 block of W. Newport on January 31, 2017 between 8:00 am & 5:50 pm.
- 1100 block of W. Newport on February 3, 2017 at 5:50 am.

### **About the Offenders:**

In one burglary, 3500 block of N. Fremont, the offender was described as a black male, 20-30 years old, 6'0" to 6'3" tall weighing between 160- 180 lbs. and wearing a yellow reflective vest.

In another burglary, 1200 block of W. Addison, there were 2 black males, both weighing between 170 -180 lbs. One of the offender(s) was wearing a red hooded sweatshirt.

In a third burglary, 1100 block of W. Newport, the offender was describes as being a black male wearing a large khaki colored jacket was seen.

### **What you can do:**

- Be aware of this crime and alert your neighbors.
- Pay special attention to any suspicious people loitering in the area.
- Make sure that all doors and windows are locked upon exiting your residence.
- If possible, purchase and maintain a working alarm system.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any vehicle description and license plate information.
