Wanted for Attempt Luring 018th District

About the Crime:

On Monday, January 30th, 2017, at approximately 7:00 p.m. in the 1500 block of West Fullerton Ave., an unknown offender attempted to lure a 10yr old and 7yr old female (walking together) to his van. The victims were returning home in the evening when they noticed a van that appeared to be identical to a van they saw near their home in the morning that same day. The victims observed a male Hispanic with a beard and slicked back black hair seated in a van. The male Hispanic driver (sole occupant) asked the victims to come here and get some candy in a deep voice. The victims ran away to their residence. The victims related that the van and offender have been seen in the area before by them but this is the first time the offender spoke to them.

About The Offender(s)

• Offender (Driver) – Believed to be a male Hispanic, Black Hair (slicked back), black beard approximately 20 to 30 years of age possibly wearing a Bears Jacket (Orange, Blue & White)

Vehicle Driven

• White Panel Type Van (possibly Ford) with only windows in the front and a dent on the driver's side by the bottom. No noticeable logos or stickers.

<u>What you can do:</u>

- Be aware of this situation and alert your neighbors.
- Call 911 to report any suspicious persons, vehicles or activity in your neighborhood.
- Do not let children walk or play alone. Identify safe havens along your child's route to school and home, such as businesses or trusted neighbors.
- Always be aware of your surroundings.
