South Side Man Charged In Connection with North Side Kidnapping



Offender: Jarqueese O'Brian Henigan, 31

Residence: 10300 Block of South Halsted St, Chicago, IL

Charges: One felony count of Aggravated Criminal Sexual Assault/Weapon
One felony count of Aggravated Kidnaping/Inflict Harm
One felony count of Vehicular Hijacking/Aggravated with a Firearm
One felony count of Possession of a Controlled Substance
One felony count of Robbery/Armed with a Firearm
One felony count of Armed Habitual Criminal
Out of State Warrant
One Misdemeanor count of Resisting/Obstructing a Police Officer

Court : Central Bond Court - 2600 S. California Avenue – March 19, 2017

Narrative: Henigan was placed into custody after being positively identified as the offender involved in the aggravated kidnapping of a 24 year old female victim. The incident occurred on March 9th, 2017 at 8:20 p.m in the 3700 block of N. Fremont Street. Henigan approached the victim armed with a handgun as she was exiting the garage. Henigan then sexually assaulted the victim and forced her into the trunk of a vehicle. Henigan then drove to several locations in the Chicagos Southside before striking a tree. Through the course of the investigation Henigan was identified and arrested on March 17th, 2017 in the 10300 block of S. Halsted and charged accordingly.
