Man Charged In Connection with Pilsen Burglaries



Offender: Eduardo Campos, 24

Residence: 1300 block of W. 19th St, Chicago, IL

Charges: Three felony counts of Burglary - Residential

Court: Central Bond Court - 2600 S. California Avenue – March 22, 2017

Narrative: Campos was placed into custody after being positively identified as the offender

involved in several burglaries in the Pilsen area. The most recent incident occurred on February 25, 2017 at 3:28 p.m in the 1300 block of W. 18th Place. Campos gained entry through a side door and took several items belonging to the victim. Campos was identified after a video was aired on a news station and was recognized by a viewer. Through the course of the investigation Campos was also charged with two other residential burglaries in the Pilsen area that occurred on December 10, 2016 and January 20, 2017. Campos was arrested on March 21, 2017 in the 1300 block of W. 19th St and charged accordingly.
