Narrative: Leonard was identified as the offender who was operating the vehicle that struck

a 73-year-old male pedestrian on the 8100 block of S. Yates on May 4, 2017 at

approximately 3:35 p.m. Leonard was in a 2002 Honda Civic travelling

northbound on Yates when he stuck the pedestrian, who was crossing the street westbound. The victim was taken to Northwestern Hospital in critical condition.
