Wanted for Attempt Child Luring 025th District (Grand Central)



About This Crime

On May 01, 2017, at approximately 9:12 p.m., the 16-year-old female juvenile was walking northbound on Long Ave. from Division St. (NE corner) when she noticed a small red 4-door sedan vehicle with a male black driver following her. The unknown offender called out to the minor attempting to get her attention. The unknown offender then curbed his vehicle, exited and walked toward the minor while brandishing a knife. The minor was able to flee to her home and alert her mother who called 911. It is believed there was a second person in the vehicle. The minor previously observed what she believed to be the same vehicle and same unknown male black offender in the area of Chicago Ave. and Pulaski Rd.

About the Offender and Vehicle

The offender is a male black, approximately 30-40 years of age, clean shaven with dark hair, brown eyes, dark complexion, and was wearing a black baseball hat with rhinestones on the top, red jacket and blue jeans. The vehicle was a small, red, 4-door sedan, unknown make or model.

What You Can Do

- Call 911 to report any suspicious persons or activity
- Walk in pairs
- Don't talk to strangers or approach strange vehicles
- Be aware of your surroundings travel in well-lit and populated areas
