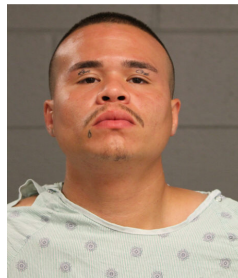

Chicago Lawn Man Charged in Fatal Traffic Crash



Offender: David A. Arocho, 24
6300 block of W. 65th Street
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One count of Reckless Homicide / Motor Vehicle
IVC – Agg DUI /Accident Death
DUI – Any Amount of Drug
Driver's License / Permit – Failure to Carry or Display
IVC – Failure to Reduce Speed
Insurance – Operate Motor Vehicle without
Issuance of Warrant – Parole Violation

Court: Central Bond Court, 26th & California – July 26, 2017

Narrative: Arocho was charged in connection to a traffic crash which occurred on July 23, 2017, at approximately 11:25 p.m. Arocho was driving a 1996 GMC Carryall e/b on Archer and rear-ended a 2003 Jeep Wagon that was stopped at a traffic signal. Upon impact, the GMC flipped and the 22-year-old female passenger travelling with Arocho was ejected from the vehicle. She sustained fatal injuries and was pronounced on scene. The 35-year-old female driver of the Jeep was uninjured. Arocho sustained non-lifethreatening injuries and was treated at Mt. Sinai. No further details are available at this time.
