Burglaries 002nd District (Wentworth)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens residing in the 002nd District (Wentworth) of burglary incidents which have occurred during the month of **August**. In these incidents, offender(s) gained entry into apartments or residences while victims were sleeping and took property from therein. In one instance, an offender displayed a blue steel semi-automatic pistol to a victim. These incidents have occurred in the geographical locations listed below:

Incident times and locations:

400 Block of E. 32nd Street on August 29, 2017 at approximately 3:30 A.M.
400 Block of E. 32nd Street on August 29, 2017 at approximately 12:00 P.M.
100 Block of E. 32nd Street on August 31, 2017 at approximately 2:00 A.M.

About the Offenders:

Offenders are described as:

1-3 Male, Blacks, 6'00-6'02, 170-180 lbs. One offender is listed as having short hair while another offender is listed as having dreadlocks.

What you can do:

- Keep the perimeter of your property well lit
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- Keep doors and windows secured
- Immediately repair any broken windows, doors or locks
- If video surveillance is available, save and make a copy of the incident for investigating detectives.
- Make an agreement with your neighbors to watch each other's homes and garages for suspicious activity.
- If you are a victim do not touch anything, call police immediately
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
