## **Wanted for Attempted Abduction 009<sup>th</sup> District (Deering)**

### **About the Crime:**

On Sunday, October 1, 2017, at approximately 7:40 pm in the 200 block of West 19<sup>th</sup> Street, an unknown male parked near the 62 year old female victim and opened his front passenger door as victim waited on the sidewalk. The male offender then exited his car and grabbed victim from behind, covering her mouth with his left hand and pushed victim towards his open car door. The victim screamed for help and was able to fight off offender. Offender let victim go and the offender fled W/B on 19<sup>th</sup> Street and then S/B onto Wells St.

### **About The Offender**

- Offender – A male White or White Hispanic race, short dark hair, between the age of 20-30 yrs, 6'00"-6'02", Light complexion, clean shaven, round face, unk eye color, and thin build . The offender did not have visible tattoos / piercings.

### **Vehicle Driven**

- Newer model tan or beige 4 door sedan. Unknown Illinois License plate. Possible last four digits being 7110. No noticeable logos or stickers or damage on the vehicle.

- Do not walk alone. Identify safe havens along your route between destination and home, such as businesses or trusted neighbors.
