## Residential Burglaries 016<sup>th</sup> District (Jefferson Park)

### **About the Crime:**

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 16<sup>th</sup> District (Jefferson Park) of recent residential burglaries that have occurred. In these incidents, unknown offender(s) have forcibly entered apartments and residences, through front or rear doors. The offender(s) also forcibly entered through rear or side windows. The offenders have taken jewelry, cash, televisions and other miscellaneous items.

### **Incident Times and Locations:**

There have been several incidents that have occurred since September 29, 2017. These incidents have taken place on Beat 1623, within the boundaries of Elston to Montrose and Cicero to Central, mostly during the day and early evening hours.

- 5000 block of W. Ainslie on September 29, 2017 between 11:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.
- 4800 block of W. Argyle on September 30, 2017 at 1:30 a.m.
- 5200 block of W. Montrose on October 16, 2017 between 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
- 4600 block of N. Milwaukee on October 18, 2017 between 7:00 p.m. – 11:40 p.m.

### **What you can do:**

- Be aware of this crime pattern and alert your friends and family about these crimes.
- Make sure all doors and windows are locked.
- Pay special attention to any suspicious subjects loitering in the area.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s), including any vehicle description and license plate information, as well as direction of flight, if known.
