Chicago Man Charged in Restaurant Shooting



Offender: Marcus Norwood, 39

400 block of East 72nd St, Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One felony count of Attempt 1st Degree Murder

Three felony counts of Armed Robbery W/Firearm

Two felony counts of Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon

Three felony counts of Aggravated Unlawful Restraint One Misdemeanor count of Obstructin Identification

Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 South California Ave. – November 1, 2017

Narrative: Norwood was arrested and charged after being identified as the offender that

entered a restaurant armed with a handgun and announced a robbery. The incident occurred on October 30, 2017 in the 0-100 block of E. Ontario at approximately 11:48 p.m. Norwood located several employees in a locker room

and restrained them and then proceeded to take their personal property.

Norwood then discharged his weapon striking a male employee, 28, in the right

arm. Norwood fled the scene on foot and was located and arrested by

responding 18th District Officers in the 0-10 block of E. Chicago Ave. without

incident. No further information is available at this time.
