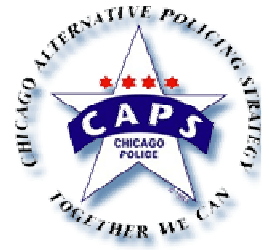

Residential Burglaries 16th District (Jefferson Park)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 16th District (Jefferson Park) of residential burglaries that have occurred in the month of November 2017. In these incidents, unknown offender(s) gain entry by forcibly kicking or prying open the front, rear or side doors and windows. Offender(s) also gain access through unlocked doors. Offender(s) then take jewelry, cash and copper piping.

Incident Times and Locations:

There have been several incidents that have occurred since November 1, 2017. These incidents have taken place on Beat 1632, within the boundaries of Belmont to Montrose/Forest Preserve Drive and Narragansett to Harlem.

- 3500 block of N. Rutherford on November 1, 2017 between 11:00 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
- 3200 block of N. Neenah on November 7-9, 2017 between 9:00 a.m. – 11:14 a.m.
- 3300 block of N. Oak Park on November 11-13, 2017 between 3:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m.
- 3600 block of N. Newland on November 14, 2017 at 12:00 p.m.
- 3300 block of N. Natchez on November 16, 2017 at 7:40 p.m.

What you can do:

- Be aware of this pattern crime and alert your friends and family about these crimes.
- Make sure all doors and windows are locked.
- Pay special attention to any suspicious subjects loitering in the area.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s), including any vehicle description and license plate information, as well as direction of flight, if known.
