### South Side Juveniles Charged in Recent Vehicular Hijackings

**Charges:** Juvenile, 15: One Felony Count of Possession of a Stolen Vehicle > \$25,000  
Three Felony Counts of Identity Theft < \$300  
One Misdemeanor Count of Driving/No License/Permit/Age

**Court:** Juvenile Court, 1100 S. Hamilton Ave., November 22, 2017

**Narrative:** Two 15-year-old male juveniles and one 16-year-old male juvenile have been charged in connection to recent vehicular hijackings on the city's south side. During the incidents, the armed offenders approached the victims while they were seated in their parked vehicles and ordered them to exit. The offenders would then flee the scene in the victim's car. These incidents occurred on November 19, 2017 on the 2300 Block of W. 115<sup>th</sup> St., and on November 13, 2017 on the 9600 block of S. Yale Ave. Area South detectives were able to view video surveillance, which led to the arrests of the offenders on November 21, 2017 in the 1200 Block of West 103<sup>rd</sup> St at approximately 3:30 p.m. The offenders were placed into custody and charged accordingly. Police believe the juvenile offenders are connected to a larger carjacking ring and the investigation is ongoing. No further information is available at this time.
