Male Juvenile Charged in Attempted Armed Robbery



Male Juvenile, 16

Charges: Juvenile, 16: One felony count of Attempt-Robbery-Armed W/Firearm
One felony count of Possession Firearm W/Defaced Serial Number

Narrative: A male juvenile is in custody after being identified as the offender in the attempted armed robbery of an off-duty Chicago Police Officer. The incident occurred on December 1, 2017 at approximately 7:04 p.m. in the 10100 block of S. Bell. On that date, the offender approached the 53-year-old male victim on the sidewalk and demanded his money while armed with a handgun. During the incident the victim discharged his weapon. The offender fled on foot and was later located and placed into custody on December 13, 2017 at approximately 12:10 p.m. in the 7300 block of S. Carpenter St. No injuries were reported and the offender was charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
