Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California Ave. – March 8, 2018

Narrative: Paris McKinley was arrested on March 6, 2018 at approximately 1:00 am in the 6200 block of South Claremont. During a traffic stop and after officers observed a firearm in his vehicle, McKinley abruptly accelerated, dragging a Chicago Police Officer several blocks before crashing into a building and fleeing on foot. He was placed into custody a short distance later and a loaded firearm was recovered from his vehicle. McKinley is due in Central Bond Court on March 8.
