South Side Man Charged with String of Commercial Burglaries in the 9th District



Offender: Daniel Rodriguez, 40
400 block of West Cermak Rd
Chicago, IL

Charges: Six felony counts of Burglary
One misdemeanor count of Forgery
One misdemeanor count of Theft of Lost or Mislaid Property

Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California Ave. – May 22, 2018

Narrative: Rodriguez was arrested by 9th District Officers on May 21, 2018 on the 2200 block of South Princeton at approximately 2:00 a.m. after he nearly struck their squad car while riding a bicycle. Rodriguez was found to be in possession of counterfeit one hundred dollar bills and a credit card that did not belong to him. Once in custody, Area Central detectives were able to identify him as the offender who committed forced entry burglaries at the following locations: 2200 block of South Wentworth on April 6th, 2000 block of South Wentworth on April 26th, 400 block West 23rd Place on May 9th, 2300 block of South Wentworth on May 16th, 2900 block of South Wentworth on May 17th, and the 2400 block of South Wentworth on May 19th. Rodriguez will appear in Central Bond Court today, May 22, 2018. No further information is available at this time.
