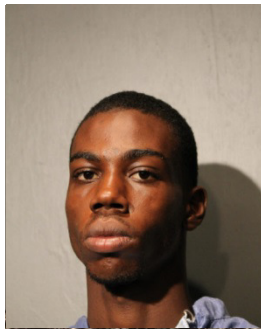

### Three Convicted Felons Charged in Armed Vehicular Hijacking



**Dwayne Liberty, 21**

**Charges:** Liberty - Vehicular Hijacking-Agg-Firearm – two felony counts of Armed Robbery W/Firearm  
Carter - Three counts of felony Vehicular Hijacking-Agg-Firearm– three felony counts of Armed Robbery W/Firearm  
Gordon - Vehicular Hijacking-Agg-Firearm – two felony counts of Armed Robbery W/Firearm

**Narrative:** Liberty, Carter and Gordon were arrested in the 400 Block of West 97<sup>th</sup> St on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at approximately 12:46 p.m. in connection with at least two aggravated vehicular hijackings. The first incident occurred in the 5100 Block of South Cornell at approximately 3:15 a.m. and the second incident hours later in the 1700 Block of North Wolcott at approximately 9:10 a.m. on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018. All three men were charged after they were positively identified as being the offenders who approached a 27-year-old man at gunpoint before taking his vehicle and personal belongings and doing the same to a 33-year-old male and female victim hours later. The offenders were observed running eastbound on 97<sup>th</sup> St after fleeing a hit-and-run traffic accident involving one of the stolen vehicles they were in and placed into custody by responding officers who were tracking one of the stolen cars using the vehicle's GPS. No further details are available at this time.
