Convicted Felon Charged in Logan Square Vehicular Hijacking



Offender: Torino Williams, 43 (AKA Trevino Williams)
6800 block of S. Dorchester Ave.
Chicago, IL

Charges: One Felony Count of Vehicular Hijacking

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California Ave. – November 8, 2018

Narrative: Torino Williams was charged in connection to a vehicular hijacking that occurred on July 14, 2018 in the 3200 block of W. Fullerton Ave. At approximately 12:00 p.m., a 43-year-old female was standing behind her vehicle attempting to pay for parking via her mobile phone when two males approached, pushed her to the ground, took her keys from her purse and fled in the vehicle. The victim sustained a broken arm during the incident. Later, it was discovered that the offenders sold the stolen vehicle via social media as the "buyers" reported the incident to police after being unable to register the vehicle. After further investigation, Torino Williams was identified as one of the offenders involved. Williams turned himself into police custody on November 6, 2018 in the 11th District and was charged accordingly. The Chicago Police continue their efforts in locating the second offender involved in the incident. No further information is available at this time.
