CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT LAUNCHES GUN OFFENDER DASHBOARD HIGHLIGHTING WEAPONS FELONY ARRESTS

The Chicago Police Department today launched its Gun Offender Dashboard, displaying the information relating to adult arrestees with at least one felony weapons-related charge, as well as any associated bond types and amounts.

The dashboard, which will be updated weekly on Wednesdays, is available to members of the public, law enforcement partners and other stakeholders for informational purposes, in a collaborative effort to keep Chicago safe and aware.

"Our commitment to transparency includes providing the public with information related to the gun crimes and arrests impacting our communities each day," said Superintendent Eddie T. Johnson. "We will continue collaborating with our partners to ensure gun offenders are held accountable in a manner consistent with a fair and impartial criminal justice system."

The available data categories include:

- arrestee name
- date of arrest
- felony charge description 1: highest severity
- felony charge description 2
- felony charge description 3
- release category (in custody or bond paid)
- bond type
- bond amount

The information, pulled from Chicago Police Department and Cook County Sheriff's Office, is reflective of the stored data at the time of posting, and is subject to change. Arrest records provided on this public portal are individuals arrested and charged as adults. All named offenders are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law. If expunged, the appropriate record(s) will be removed in accordance with the applicable requirements.
