South Side Man Charged in May Homicide



Offender: James Reed, 34
5900 Block of S. Throop
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) Felony Count: Murder – First Degree
One (1) Felony Count: Attempt-Murder-First Degree

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California Ave. – July 10th, 2020

Narrative: Reed was arrested by the Fugitive Apprehension Unit/U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force on July 8th, 2020 at approximately 11:54 a.m. in the 10200 Block of South Perry. He was positively identified through investigation as the individual who after a verbal altercation shot two people in the 5900 Block of S. Carpenter on May 31st, 2020 at approximately 4:25 p.m. A 29-year-old woman suffered a gunshot wound to the abdomen and was transported to the University of Chicago Hospital while an 18-year-old woman suffered gunshot wounds to the chest and back. She was pronounced at St. Bernard Hospital. Reed was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
