### Two Offenders Charged with Attempt First Degree Murder

**Charges:** Juvenile, 17  
Three Felony Counts – of Attempt First Degree Murder  
Three Felony Counts – of Agg/ Discharge of a firearm toward police officer  
One Felony Count of Agg/ Unlawful use of Weapon person under 21 years old  
One Misdemeanor Charge of Criminal Trespass to Land

**Charges:** Kamari Pleasant, 22  
Three Felony Counts – Agg/ Discharge of a firearm towards police officer  
One Felony Count of Unlawful use of Weapon by felon  
Three Felony Counts – of Attempt First Degree Murder

**Court:** Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California Ave. – November 24, 2020

**Narrative:** The above individuals were identified as the offenders who fired handguns at police officers on November 21, 2020, in the 10400 block of South Wallace at approximately 10:10pm. The offenders fled on foot from police, but were later found and taken into custody by a K-9 unit in the 10400 block of South Wallace on November 21, 2020, at approximately 10:20pm and charged accordingly.
