Preliminary Statement on Police-Involved Shooting on Inbound 290 and Mannheim

CHICAGO – On Thursday, April 22, 2021, at approximately 4:10 p.m., police attempted to stop a vehicle of a suspect wanted for a murder investigation. The suspect's vehicle crashed near Mannheim Road on the I-290 Expressway where he exited his vehicle and he apparently attempted to carjack a passing vehicle. A Chicago Police Officer exited his vehicle and intervened, which resulted in the officer discharging his service weapon striking the offender in the arm. Two firearms were recovered and the offender was transported to an area hospital. No officers were injured in the incident.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department. The Officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a period of 30 days.
