Juvenile Offender Charged with Murder of 17-Year-Old Male, Attempted Murder of 15-Year-Old Male



Offender: Male juvenile, 14

Charges: One (1) felony count – Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm

Court: Juvenile Detention Hearing – 1100 S. Hamilton – April 23, 2024

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on April 22, 2024, at 8:16 a.m., in the 100 block of S. Central Park Blvd. He was identified as the offender who shot and killed a 17-year-old male on March 2, 2024, in the 500 block of W. Roosevelt Rd. (1st District). A 15-year-old male was also shot and injured. The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
