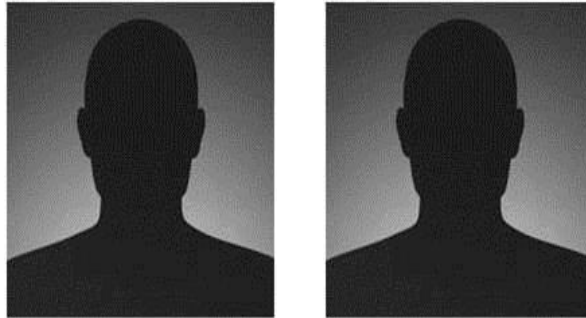

Offenders Charged with November 2022 Attempted Murder of 34-Year-Old Male

Offender #1: Khalid Mahadi, 20

11200 block of S. Vernon Ave., Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt – Murder – First Degree
Two (2) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – UUW – Weapon – Felon, Posses/Use Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated UUW/Loaded – No FCCA-FOID

Offender #2: Elijah Washington, 22

11200 block of S. Vernon Ave., Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt – Murder – First Degree
Two (2) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – UUW – Weapon – Felon, Posses/Use Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated UUW/Loaded – No FCCA-FOID

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – March 28, 2023

Narrative: The above offenders were arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on March 27, 2023, in the 2600 block of S. California. They were identified as the offenders who, on November 26, 2022, shot a 34-year-old male multiple times in the 11200 block of S. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr. (5th District).
