
Burglary Prevention Checklist for Homes



WINDOWS Not all burglars break glass, so make sure window locks are strong and properly used.

Burglars love hiding behind shrubs while they pry open windows without being seen. Keep shrubs trimmed.

Keep doors locked even when home. Be aware of glass near door and protect against breaking and entering.

Your Burglary Prevention Checklist

Are your doors and windows locked every time you leave?		
Are all entry areas unobstructed by shrubbery etc. to permit maximum visibility?		
Does your sliding door have a secondary lock?		
Is your sliding door prevented from lifting off its track?		
Do you have an alarm system?		
Do you always set your alarm?		
Are the windows on your second floor secured?		
Do you have a list, picture or video of all your valuables including serial numbers?		
Is your house number clearly visible from the street?		
Are windows at least 40" from any door locks?		
Are all entrances and gangways well lit and free of concealment?		
Are your ladders or bins that might be used to gain entry out of sight?		
Are your garage doors and windows locked and secured?		
Are valuables blocked from being visually seen from the street?		
Can you see who is at the door without opening it?		
Do you have motion sensor lights installed?		
Are the gates to your yard locked?		
Do you have high definition surveillance cameras?		
Do you lock up outdoor valuables such as grills, lawnmowers, etc?		
Do you have inside lights on timers?		
Is your safe secured to the floor?		
Do you know how to access your security video including the password?
